

### Health


We are committed to promoting the health, safety, and well-being of all children and families in our care.

Anthony felt the call to help children who were on their way to aging out of the foster care system. Through this call he started doing respite services with NewPath Child and Family Services. While he was doing respite he adopted his three children, Blade, Matthew, and Christian.

Blade was in a group home in Dayton, OH and according to his county case worker, it was one of the best in the state. It was hopeless, to say the least. Blade's caseworker described him as, "A lost child with darting eyes looking for safety and unsure of himself." This group home was in an area of West Dayton with high crime rates and failing schools.





Christian came to Anthony's house after being kicked out the week of Christmas. He had moved every 6 months since he was nine years old. He would act out and the foster parents wouldn't understand what was going on.

He joined Anthony's house, and still struggled the same. However, Anthony saw that in his actions he was trying to communicate. There were times Christian ran away, became physically violent, and all around difficult. Christian's caseworker described him as someone that without the proper guidance would go down a very dangerous sprial of actions and drug addiction.

Christian's case worker determined he needed to go into a group home, but just before she placed him there, he came to Anthony's house.





Matthew joined Anthony's house after a two week respite where the county tried to salvage an adoption. Ultimately his adoption was disrupted. Matthew came in and had a smile on, but internally it was eating him up. He had hoped that someone finally was giving him the change at stability, but that was quickly ripped from underneath him.

Once Matthew was fully placed with Anthony, he started acting out. He had so much anger and anxiety built up inside of him. As time passed it came to a boiling point and he required emergency hospitalization due to actions he was taking.





Blade, Matthew and Christian have aged several years since their adoption. Blade came to Anthony's house and had already failed the 9th grade and seemed unsure and unsafe in his surroundings. Anthony worked with him with an excellent school system to help him recover the time he had lost.

At his adoption, his caseworker cried stating, "This is an adoption I am forever going to remember - Blade is sure of himself, and all smiles. He truly completely turned around." In 2023, Blade ended up graduating 6 months EARLY!







At Christian's matching for his adoption every agency worker was amazed, because there were situations that happened that most people gave up. Christian finally had someone who didn't give up on him.

Today Christian is thriving, having someone to help him guide through life's journeys, and receiving the appropriate medical care and behavioral health services. He has finally connected with a counselor, that which was a huge step for him - because in his past going to the counselor's office meant you might get picked up by someone else and be in a different home.





Matthew went from scared and anxious to vivacious and sassy. He has built a group of friends that he can have for a lifetime. And he has built a relationship with Anthony's Mom, Brenda, who he fondly calls Grandma.

He has learned that it is safe to tell people how you really feel and get the help that you need.

It isn't scary to go places because things can stay the same, and that is great.





Every day there are over 400,000 children who are in foster care across the United States. Nearly 50% (200,000) kids are placed into group homes, just like Blade was. Homes that have historically been unsafe and focused more on the money than on really changing the outcome for any kids.

Anthony's Villa wants to change that.

We plan on delivering a multi-faceted approach to changing the face of foster care and group homes across the United States.

Through the following pages you will learn about how we plan to scale to serve children in out of home placement differently than ever before, that way we can truly create a brighter future, for everyone.


